## ORDINANCE NO. 37

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR FERE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION IN CONNECTION WITH HAZARDOUS MATERIALS AND PROCESSES.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SHELLY, NORMAN COUNTY, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

## Section 1. Adoption of Fire Prevention Code.

There is hereby adopted by the Village of Shelly, Norman ounty, Minnesota, for the purpose of providing for fire protection and prevention in connection with hazardous materials and processes, that certain code known as the Fire Prevention Code, Abbreviated Edition, recommended by the National Board of Fire Underwriters of New York, being particularly the 1949 edition thereof and the whole thereof, of which not less than three copies have been and now are filed in the office of the clerk of the Village of Shelly and same are hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein, and from the date on which this ordinance shall take effect, the provisions thereof shall be controlling within the limits of the Village of Shelly.

Section 2. Definitions.

Wherever the word "Municipality" is used in said code, it shall be held to mean the Village of Shelly.

Section 3. Establishment of Limits in which Bulk Storage or Flamable Liquids is prohibited.

The limits in section 312 of said code in which bulk storage of flamable liquids in outside aboveground tanks is prohibited are hereby established as follows: Block 1 and the North Half of Block 2 of Mauritson's First Addition to Shelly, Minnesota; the North Half of Blocks 5 and 11 and the South Half of Blocks 6 and 10 of Mauritson's Second Addition to Shelly, Minnesota; Blocks 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Original Townsite of Shelly, Minnesota, all being according to the official plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Norman County, Minnesota.

Section 4. Validity.

The invalidity of any section or provision of this ordinance or of code hereby adopted shall not invalidate other sections or provisions thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by Law.

Section 6. Any violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) or by imprisonment in the County Jail of Norman County for a period of not less than ten days.
