

ORDINANCE NO. 87

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SHELLY, MINNESOTA, AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 86, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SHELLY, MINNESOTA ADOPTING DOG AND CAT REGULATIONS, INCLUDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF" BY LIMITING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF ANIMALS FOR EACH HOUSEHOLD.

THE CITY OF SHELLY ORDAINS, as follows:

**Section 1.** Ordinance No 86 ("An Ordinance of the City of Shelly, Minnesota Adopting Dog and Cat Regulations, Including Penalties for Violation Thereof"), Section 11 entitled "Various Offenses" is amended by adding the following provision:

(L) Maximum Number of Animals Permitted Per Household. The number of licensed dogs and cats exceeding three months of age permitted for each household shall not exceed five total animals. Any existing household which becomes nonconforming on the effective date of this Ordinance shall not have the number of permitted animals enlarged, but may continue with the existing dogs and cats until the expiration of the lives of those excess dogs and cats.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to laws of the State of Minnesota.

Upon a call of ayes and nays as to the passage of this Ordinance, the vote stood as follows:

Voting in the negative: None
