

ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN CERTAIN MANNERS DECLARED UNLAWFUL AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SHELLY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 - SQUEALING TIRES, GRINDING GEARS AND BACK-FIRING.

No person shall operate a vehicle within the Village of Shelly in such manner as to cause the tires to squeal or the gears to grind or the motor to back-fire or to cause the tires to throw sand and gravel, except when an emergency creates a necessity for such operation.

Section 2 - ERRATIC DRIVING. No person shall operate a vehicle on any street in the Village of Shelly at an erratic or irregular and changing speed, except when traffic conditions necessitate such operation.

Section 3 - PARKING OR HALTING. No person shall park or halt a vehicle on the main traveled portion of any street or highway in the Village of Shelly unless directed to do so by a peace officer or unless traffic conditions necessitate such parking or halting.

Section 4 - PENALTIES. Any person guilty of a violation of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor, and, upon a conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.
