## Ordinance No. 31

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES.

The village council of Shelly do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following ordinances be and the same are hereby repealed:

Ordinance No. 1, fixing penalty of official bonds; passed August 22, 1902.

Ordinance No. 2, providing for the manner of constructing sidewalks and crosswalks in the village of Shelly; passed August 29, 1902.

Ordinance No. 3, preventing the increase of fire risks; passed August 29, 1902.

Ordinance No. 4, regulating slaughtering houses; passed January 9, 1903.

Ordinance No. 5, regulating pool tables; passed February 3,

Ordinance No. 6, prohibiting the playing of cards, use of slot machines, dice and the sale of tonic or hard cider in restaurants, temperance saloons and places where soft drinks are sold, in the village of Shelly; passed November 17, 1903.

Ordinance No. 8, for dog tax; passed July 3, 1904.

Ordinance No. 12, regulating the penning up of poultry; passed July 12, 1915.

Ordinance No. 13, regulating motion picture shows, vaudeville shows, medicine shows and peddlers; passed May 22, 1916.

Section 2. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the ordinances adopted on the 30th day of November, 1927 numbered 15 to 31, inclusive are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance will take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication of the ordinances included in the revision mentioned in Section 2 above.
