

Ordinance No. 32

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE OPERATION ^{of} VEHICLES AND THE USE OF THE STREETS
OF THIS VILLAGE.

The Village Council of the Village of Shelly do Ordain :

Section 1 The provisions of titles I, II, and III of the Uniform Highway Traffic Act, as set forth in chapter 412 of the Session Laws of Minnesota for 1927, are hereby adopted as a traffic code for this Village; and it shall be unlawful for any person to operate any vehicle in the Village, or to use the streets of this Village in any manner contrary to that prescribed in those titles of the said act.

SECTION 2. Penalties. Any person violating any provision of the traffic code of this Village shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and be punished as follows: Provided any person driving a vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or narcotics shall be punished as follows: For the first offence, by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00 or imprisonment of not less than 10 days, and costs ; for all subsequent offences, by imprisonment of not less than ten days nor more than three months, and costs ;
