Ordinance No. 25

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PERMITS FOR THE SALE AT RETAIL OF CERTAIN FIREWORKS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The village council of Shelly do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. Fireworks Business Regulated. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or offer for sale, display, or give away any fireworks except under permit secured as hereinafter provided. Such permit shall not be construed to authorize the sale of any fireworks the use of which has been forbidden in the village.

Sec. 2. Permits. Persons desiring to secure permits to sell fireworks shall apply therefor to the recorder upon a blank form furnished by the village. The fee for such permit shall be \$2.00 and shall accompany the application. Such permits shall be valid only between June 25, and July 4, inclusive, of the year in which issued.

Sec. 3. Penalty. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.
