Ordinance No. 22

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS.

The village council of Shelly do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. Sidewalks To Be Brought to Grade. It shall be the duty of the Street Commissioner to bring to grade all sidewalks ordered in by the Village Council in the same manner as provided for the grading of roadways.

Sec. 2. Sidewalks To Be Built on the Established Grade. All sidewalks constructed or reconstructed in this village shall be constructed on the established grade on file in the office of the village recorder.

Sec. 3. Sidewalks To Be Built According to Specifications. All sidewalks shall be constructed of cement concrete according to the specifications adopted by the Council and on file in the office of the Village Recorder.

Sec. 4. Construction To Be Supervised. All sidewalks ordered constructed, reconstructed, or repaired by the Council shall be constructed under the supervision of the Village Engineer or any member of the road and bridge committee of the Council.
